- 1) Forms signed for sending tax forms to State.
- 2) Patrick O Brien would like a Warranty Deed to the Eva Lord Property. Last meeting we decided to check with Bud Runyon. Bud feels we should issue a Warranty Deed to Gordon Hall, not to Patrick O Brien. No special Town Meeting is scheduled, Warren & Bonnie agree to wait until regular Town Meeting. Matter tabled until March. MOTION: Wait to hear from Mr. Hall till we act on above. Seconded. VOTE.
- 3) David Birchfield would like to join Bocca. Was Bocca Code as adopted, as up-dated? If so, the Code in book at time of printing is legal Building Code. MOTION MADE: Letter to Bocca asking amount of dues, if less than cost of book, join. Seconded. VOTE.
- 4) Sewer Project: Morton & Rose have been contacted to draw up plans.
- 5) Regional Artist's League: have requested use of Town Hall 1st two weeks in August. Money goes to Rescue Unit and Schlorships. Want to use hall only if no charge. MOTION: The Regional Artist's League may use the Town Hall for the first two weeks of August at no charge. Seconded VOTE.
- 6) Dump: No change - no meeting. Sebago Technics to do site evaluation. Ronnie to talk with young Normantus.
- 7) Debbie Sanborn problem: P roblem line not with Plummer, but with someone in Alfred.
- 8) \$1454 Block Grant to be set aside for 1988 tax abatement. Motion made and Seconded VOTE.
- 9) Auditor will be here within two weeks.
- 10) Sidewalks: Warren has not talked to Robert Sturgeon re Mannings.
- 11) Danny Day agreed to take down the tree at Tarbox's.
- 12) York County Shelter request for information regarding Budget meeting.
- 13) Patten Corporation has sent a letter asking for form to be filled out, re Patten Corp. and the handling of rubbish for the development.
