

## Selectmen's Meeting September 9, 2009

Vinal Pendexter was present for the meeting.

Warrants and minutes were reviewed and signed.

A request to use Pike Hall on October 10<sup>th</sup> for a wedding reception was addressed. Vinal tested the toilets in both restrooms and reports they are working fine. He spoke with Paul Lyle who worked on the toilets earlier this year for his input and Paul agreed. Motion made to allow use of Pike Memorial Hall for the wedding provided there be no access to the balcony. Seconded and approved. The vote was two for and one against.

Tabled the re-appointment of Joe Rankin and Peg Maxwell to the Fairgrounds Advisory Committee.


