1. PLOWING AND SANDING CONTRACT.

BIDS: DAY'S EXCAVATING, 57,750.00 per snow removal season.

LIMERICK STEEPLEJACKS, 61,200.00 per snow removal season.

Current low bid was Day's Excavating 57,750.00.

2. Warrant #6 was passed and signed by all.
